BRIEF BIOGRAPHY

Anna was called to the New South Wales Bar in May 2021. She is also a member of the Victoria Bar.

Anna is familiar with complex energy pricing principles, transfer pricing and benchmarking, oil and gas pricing, take-or-pay contracts, the short term traded gas market and rules, offtake agreements, access arrangements and regulated infrastructure. In addition, she has experience working with airports and gas pipeline operators. Anna has acted for major gas companies and manufactures on matters concerning the National Gas Law and Rules and the Electricity Law and Rules as well as other energy and gas laws and regulations.
